NEW MEMBER RANGE SAFETY DEMO PROCEDURE

For the purposes of this demonstration, the Member may use their own firearm or may use a firearm provided by the Club. The Member may fire from any safe stance or position they choose and may use a rest if so desired.

Any firearm used must be unloaded prior to the demonstration.

The Member, when directed, will:

- 1. Safely approach the designated shooting lane, demonstrate the firearm is clear, and place the firearm safely on the shooting bench.
- 2. Safely load <u>five</u> rounds into a magazine for a semi-automatic firearm or the cylinder for a revolver.
- 3. Load the magazine into the pistol or close the cylinder of the revolver and fire <u>three</u> rounds at a Club provided 17" x 22" target placed 21 feet downrange. All shots must impact the target paper.
- 4. Unload the firearm, show that the firearm is clear, and place the firearm safely on the shooting bench.
