- INDOOR PISTOL RANGE STATIONS 1, 3, & 5 ONLY OPEN TO MEMBERS AND GUESTS SIX PEOPLE MAXIMUM IN THE RANGE AT ANY TIME
- BUILDINGS OPEN FOR MEETINGS ONLY
- ORIENTATION OPEN

### **Changes to the Club Constitution and Bylaws**

In accordance with Club Bylaw Article XII, the following changes to the Club Constitution and Bylaws were approved by the Club Members at the June Monthly Meeting.

#### Section 3.11.a.1, which read:

1. Junior Member

In order to become a Junior Club Member, the candidate's parent or legal guardian shall submit a request to the Club Membership Committee.

The candidate:

- a. must be either:
  - 1. the child of a Club Member in good standing, or...

was changed to read:

1. the child, ward, or grandchild of a Club Member in good standing, or...

Section 3.11.h, which read:

h. shall be supervised by parent or guardian at all times while on Club property, and... was changed to read:

h. shall be supervised by parent, **grandparent**, or guardian at all times while on Club property, and...

Section 3.11.i, which read:

i. may participate in Club Leagues and events when accompanied by parent or legal guardian.

was changed to read:

 may participate in Club Leagues and events when accompanied by parent, grandparent, or legal guardian.

### **Club Safety Violations**

On 4 June, the Board of directors met to discuss a serious safety violation.

A club member signed in on the Outdoor range prior to 09:00 (07:15) and proceeded to shoot. A neighbor, who was a club member, quickly arrived at the club and informed the member of the violation.

### According to the Club Range Rules:

Section A.1

Shooting on a closed range could endanger lives and is strictly prohibited.

Section A.3

The Outdoor Rifle/Pistol Range is open to Members from 09:00 to 1/2 hour after sunset.

Exceptions: All day on Thanksgiving and Christmas, and periodically for Club sanctioned events, e.g. Outdoor Pin Shoots, Cowboy Action Shooting Matches, and .22 Rimfire Plate Shoots.

As the club property is currently available for turkey hunting for members, from legal hunting hours until 09:00, shooting before 09:00 is a serious violation of the rules. This is also a public relations nightmare with respect to our neighbors.

This member has lost his range privileges and is now required to attend an orientation to have them reinstated. As this was a safety violation, the board could have imposed any number of penalties, including expulsion from the club.

It is each member's responsibility to know the current rules of the club. They are posted on the website. Each member signs a renewal document that states that they are familiar with the current rules. It is on each member to do all they can to protect the club.

### **Protect the Club**

- Members must fill out Liability Waivers each and every time their guest steps on club property. (Anyone who does not have their own swipe card is considered a guest).
- 2. Members are writing "Guest" in the logbook, instead of the Guest's hometown or relationship to the member.
- 3. Some members are even failing to fill in the logbook for themselves. (We have compiled a list of names from the swipe card system).

The logbook and the Liability Waivers are there to protect your club. Please do your part or we will be forced to protect the club by limiting your access to the facilities. We have had 60+ violations of this policy this year.

Henceforth, when a violation occurs, a letter will be sent to the member, requesting that they appear before the board to explain their actions.



### Proposed Changes to the Club Constitution and Bylaws

In accordance with Club Bylaw Article XII, the following proposed changes to the Club Constitution and Bylaws have been submitted to the Board of Directors for a First Reading, and subsequently to the Members at the June Monthly Meeting for a Second Reading. These changes will be voted on at the next regular Monthly Meeting, and are subject only to a "Yes" or "No" vote. No changes or amendments are allowed prior to the vote.

#### PROPOSED CHANGE

To add Bylaw Section 3.12

3.12 GUESTS

- a. Any person who does not possess a legitimate Club Membership Card, including immediate family (spouse and children under 18), is considered a Guest.
- b. If a Member brings a guest, the Member shall enter the name of the guest in the Range Log under Member's name and the town of residence in the badge number space. The word "guest" is unacceptable. For guests who are immediate family, the words "SPOUSE", "SON", or "DAUGHTER" may be used instead of town of residence.
- c. All guests must complete and sign a Liability Release form immediately upon entering Club, each and every time they enter Club property, and deposit it in the appropriate file box. It is the Club Member's responsibility to ensure that this is done.
- d. Members may host no more than three guests at any one time, but any guest must be accompanied by the host Member at all times when handling firearms or shooting on any range.
- e. Guests must relinquish shooting lanes to Members if there are not enough lanes for everyone to shoot.
- f. No person may be a guest more than three times per year. This limit shall not apply to guests who are immediate family.
- g. The Club Member is entirely responsible for the actions of their guests.

#### PROPOSED CHANGE

To add Bylaw Section 11.4.a.(6)

(6) Suspend range privileges until such time as the Member successfully completes a Club Orientation Session. The Member may be required to pay the then current Orientation Fee to attend.

### **Politics & Legislation**

#### **Federal**

On Monday, 15 June 2020, the US Supreme court declined to take up a series of new cases seeking to expand gun rights. The court rejected ten different cases that had piled up in recent months. One of the cases was a dispute from New Jersey about the states concealed carry gun permits. People who want to carry handguns in public must show they have a special reason before they can get a permit. A challenge to the Massachusetts "assault weapons" ban and Cook County, Illinois similar ban was turned down by the court. On 27 April 2020, the court dismissed a National Rifle Association-backed challenge to repeal New York City restriction on handgun owners transporting their firearms outside the home. This restriction was repealed later by the city after legal review. The U.S. Supreme Court is sidestepping a major ruling regarding the US Constitution's 2nd Amendment.

#### **New Hampshire**

The legislature is in session this week for the first time since March. To no one's surprise, 26 riders have been scheduled to be introduced; three hundred forty pages of non-related amendments to the bills that were introduced before the unexpected shutdown. They are trying to railroad legislation through. DC style politics have truly taken over the New Hampshire State House.

The state committees have been busy, either electronically or in small closed-door meetings, with no public input about their proposed changes and amendments. There was no input from the House committees to the Senate about proposed changes. Fortunately, the time limits set for changes has expired. The House tried to change the rules about the time limits which was stopped by the Senate on a majority vote.

It seems the House wants to change the rules when they run out of time or proper procedures to accomplish their shenanigans.

There are bills that need to be stopped regarding firearms, in one case paintball guns. The Education bill, HB 1558, has been amended to create suspension problems for children that merely possess a paintball gun. This is not about bringing a marker to school, just owning one. The possession of a paintball marker could be used to extend a suspension of a student.

Ever vigilant is the only way we can counter these attacks on our rights. The local, state, and national elections are more important than ever.
