

The NH legislative session for 2016 is underway. It promises to be a very contentious session.

The House passed this year's version of Constitutional Carry and also passed the bill for use of suppressors for hunting; both head to the Senate. Last year the Senate passed Constitutional Carry for the first time, which the Governor vetoed. This year it will be touch and go to get it passed by the Senate and the Governor is likely to veto both bills if they make it to her desk. Fish and Game vehemently opposes the suppressor bill.

HB 1368, requiring firearms owners to have liability insurance, would require up to \$10,000 of liability insurance on each and every firearm you buy if enacted. The insurance is on the firearm not the owner.

HB 1314, a bill limiting the authority of state entities to regulate the sale, use, and possession of firearms, should be familiar to you. Our friends in Concord have tried to pass this type of legislation before.

HB 1400 is a bill defining suitable person for the purpose of obtaining a license to carry a firearm and extending the term of the license. We have been trying to get "suitable" defined in the law for several years. Although NH is a "shall issue" state some of our local authorities think it is a "may issue" state like our neighbor to the South. (We like this one.)

## **Politics & Legislation**

HB 1416, a bill relative to funding for state criminal background checks, ostensibly establishes a fund for a full time position in the Licensing division of the state police. The DOS licensing division budget already provides for \$375,000 in revenue to cover current licensing personnel and division costs.

HB 1474 would require the collection of data relative to firearm related deaths and injuries. The Uniform Crime Reporting Unit of the New Hampshire State Police already collects this data and submits it to the UCR/FBI.

HB 1632-FN would establish a criminal penalty for providing a firearm to a person prohibited from possessing one. Federal law already does this.

HB 1635: relative to the theft of a firearm during a burglary. Tortuously written, the bill makes theft of a firearm a Class A felony. Reading the entire text, too lengthy to print here, will disclose the dangerous ambiguity in this bill.

HB 1657: prohibiting firearms in certain public places. With the exception of polling places, the bill imposes the state over private property rights.

SB 389: relative to the penalty for possession of multiple firearms. Reaffirms that a "unit of prosecution" under RSA 159:3 -a, refers to each occurrence of possession rather than each





#### individual firearm.

SB 455: relative to immunity for injuries from the possession or use of a firearm by an employee or official of a political subdivision. Relieves political subdivisions from liability.

The NH House voted 231-121 to approve HB 512, prohibiting the confiscation of firearms and ammunition during emergencies, and grants law enforcement officers immunity for refusing to follow illegal confiscation orders. The bill goes to the Senate for consideration.

On the Federal level: The surge of criminal background checks required of new gun purchasers has been so unrelenting in recent months that the FBI was forced to temporarily halt processing of thousands of appeals from prospective buyers whose purchases were denied. -- USA Today January 20, 2016.

The annual battle of the people's Constitutional rights and the government's efforts to control our daily lives marches on!
