Absent Companions Peter Gulazian

CPF&G Club Member #3413



Peter Joseph Gulazian, 75, of Conway and former longtime Newburyport, MA resident, passed in the early hours of 22 Feb 2016, at the Memorial Hospital in North Conway.

Born in Newburyport on 3 Sep 1940, he graduated from Newburyport High School in 1958, where he was a three-sport standout in football, basketball, and baseball. He was the first winner of the Palumbo Award for outstanding play by a lineman in 1957, and also the recipient of the Ryan Cup in 1958.

Peter went on to the University of New Hampshire in Durham, where he played football and earned his bachelor's degree in education. During his college years and beyond, Peter was a Lifeguard at Salisbury Beach State Reservation. He returned to his Alma Mater where he taught social studies for 38 years, and also served as an assistant coach on the baseball and football teams for much of that time. In 1988, Peter helped found the Newburyport High School golf program and served as the teams head coach until 2001. One of Peter's proudest moments was his Induction to the Newburyport High School Wall of Fame on 6 Nov 2014.

His memberships included the Cape Ann League, Port Golf League, North Conway Country Club, Pease Golf Course, and, as a sportsman, Peter was a proud member of Ducks Unlimited, Country Pond Fish and Game Club and Carrol County Fish and Game Club.

He is survived by his daughter, Debra Lesynski and husband, Jay, of Newburyport; his former wife of 25 years, Beverly Gulazian of Salisbury; and many friends and colleagues.

NH SB 336: Anyone who is not prohibited by state or federal statute from possessing a firearm is de facto qualified to receive a New Hampshire pistol/revolver license. This bill, which was passed by the House and Senate, languishes on the Governor's desk, waiting for her signature or the end of the legislative session to become law. Unfortunately, the Governor has vowed to veto this pro-gun legislation as she did last session.

Here is a rundown of the legislative activity this session:

HB 1368– requires the seller, purchaser, and owner of a firearm to be covered by a qualified liability insurance policy - Killed in the House

HB 1600 – prohibits the possession of a flamethrower - Killed in the House.

HB??? – prohibits all firearm possession at hospitals and doctor's offices, polling places, entertainment venues seating more than 5,000, and anywhere liquor is sold - Killed in the House.

HB 1474 – requires the commissioner of the Dept. of Safety to make an annual report relative to firearm

related deaths and injuries - Killed in the House.

HB 1416 – allows a reasonable fee for performing criminal background checks for firearms, and establishes a position of counter clerk in the Dept. of Safety to conduct state criminal background checks - Killed in the House.

HB 1635 – increases the penalty for the theft of a firearm during a burglary.

SB 455 – provides that a political subdivision is not liable for injuries resulting from the possession or use of a firearm or knife by a government employee - Tabled in the Senate.

SB 389 – makes small revisions to the law against felons owning firearms -Killed in the House.

HB 1314 – prohibits a state university, institution, or entity funded by the state of NH, from regulating the sale or possession of firearms - Killed in the House.

HB 1288 – permits members of the National Guard to carry concealed weapons at National Guard facilities -Passed by the House.





SB 547 – establishes a commission to study if current force protection measures provide adequate safeguards for NH National Guard personnel, facilities, and equipment - Passed by the Senate.

HB 1645 – allows a person to carry a loaded pistol or revolver in a car so long as the firearm is not concealed -Killed in House.

HB 1132 – allows a person to carry a loaded rifle or shotgun in a motor vehicle, OHRV, snowmobile, boat, aircraft, or other vehicle, so long as there is not a round in the chamber and the safety is on - Passed by the House.

HB 1400 – removes police officers' discretion to determine if a person is "suitable" to carry a concealed firearm, and extends the term of the concealed carry license by one year - Killed in the House.

This is a partial list of this year's legislative activity concerning firearm rights. This is for informational purposes only. Bills are not laws until the governor signs them in to law.
