

Changes to the Club Constitution and Bylaws

The following changes to the Club Constitution and Bylaws were approved by the Membership at the September Meeting.

To change Bylaw Section 3.2:

3.2 There will be five classes of membership:

- a. Regular
- b. Military
- c. Honorary
- d. Senior
- e. Life

to read:

3.2 There will be six classes of membership:

- a. Regular
- b. Military
- c. Honorary
- d. Senior
- e. Life
- f. Probationary

To add Bylaw Section 3.10:

3.10 Probationary Member

- a. A newly accepted Club Member shall be considered Probationary for one full year, starting on the date voted in as a Club Member.
- b. Probationary Members must meet all the requirements as set forth under the Section regarding Regular Members.
- c. Subject to the conditions set forth in the following parts of this section, Probationary Members shall have all the rights and privileges of Regular Members.
- d. During their Probationary year, the Member must work a minimum of sixteen (16) hours at Club Work Parties or Events. All hours worked must be approved by the appropriate Work Party or Event Coordinator. Failure to comply with this requirement shall result in the Member being refused the right to apply for Membership Renewal.
- e. Any new Member accepted under the Married Couples Discount provision must work a minimum of eight (8) hours at Club Work Parties or Events. All hours worked must be approved by the appropriate Work Party or Event Coordinator. Failure to comply with this requirement shall result in the Member being refused the right to apply for Membership Renewal.
- f. This Section shall not apply to Honorary Members.

Politics & Legislation

I thought I would never see people running for high office in the Granite State advocating restricting or eliminating our gun-rights as the theme of their candidacy for election.

The Democrat candidate for Governor, who won the primary, openly advocates against “assault weapons”, Constitutional Carry, stand your ground laws, and favors “Red Flag” laws.

At the last Gun Owners of New Hampshire meeting, held on September 19th, Michael Hammond, attorney for Gun Owners of America, addressed the gathering with horror stories of “Red Flag Laws” currently on the books of five or six deep blue states. Here’s how the law works: If a family member or guardian or next-door neighbor accuses you of strange or erratic behavior they can go to the court and request intervention. To date 98% of these requests have been granted. You are not allowed to attend these hearings and you can expect to spend anywhere between ten and twenty thousand dollars on attorney fees to get your firearms returned to you. Unfortunately, a “Red Flag Law” has been enacted in Massachusetts, sorry guys.

There are people in political office and running for office in NH who think “Red Flag Laws” are a great idea and very much needed to protect us. Protect us from who, ourselves?

After Mike had addressed the meeting a general discussion on what to expect in November and the importance of this mid-term. I must ask this question. How many of you voted in the primary? How many will vote in the general mid-term election?

I know this is a song you have heard me sing many times, but if we don’t turn out in great numbers for this election we are cutting our own throats. The importance of what is happening in Washington, DC and Concord, NH can’t be stressed strongly enough. The Second Amendment is under constant attack in the DC Swamp and our hard fought for rights here in NH are facing an uncertain future.

A lot of people who live above the Notches consider Rockingham County, where most of us reside, as Massachusetts North. Don’t take the old line “It can’t happen here” as Gospel. It can happen here and there are many people in our state that are working diligently to make it happen here.

With the appointment of Brett Kavanaugh to the Supreme Court when confirmed, I hope, we stand an excellent chance of maintaining and maybe improving our Second Amendment rights. If the Democrats stonewall the appointment until after the mid-term and we lose our majority Judge Kavanaugh will never sit on the Supreme Court of the United States of America. Be safe and VOTE!






