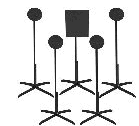

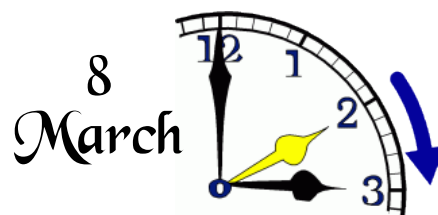

Proposed Changes to the Club Constitution and Bylaws

In accordance with Club Bylaw Article XII, the following proposed changes to the Club Constitution and Bylaws have been submitted to the Board of Directors for a First Reading, and subsequently to the Members at the February Monthly Meeting for a Second Reading. These changes will be voted on at the next regular Monthly Meeting, and are subject only to a "Yes" or "No" vote. No changes or amendments are allowed prior to the vote.

PROPOSED CHANGE

To change Section 3.11.a.1, which currently reads:

3.11 Junior Member

In order to become a Junior Club Member, the candidate's parent or legal guardian shall submit a request to the Club Membership Committee.

The candidate:

- a. must be either:
 1. the child of a Club Member in good standing, or...

to read:

1. the child, **ward, or grandchild** of a Club Member in good standing, or...

To change Section 3.11.h, which currently reads:

- h. shall be supervised by parent or guardian at all times while on Club property, and...

to read:

- h. shall be supervised by parent, **grandparent**, or guardian at all times while on Club property, and...

To change Section 3.11.i, which currently reads:

- i. may participate in Club Leagues and events when accompanied by parent or legal guardian.

to read:

- i. may participate in Club Leagues and events when accompanied by parent, **grandparent**, or legal guardian.

The Graham Combat Killhouse Rules

1. **NOBODY IS COMING TO SAVE YOU**

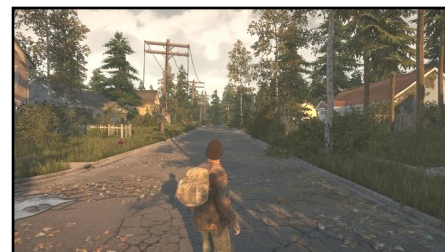
Whether an event lasts a few seconds, a few hours, or even a few days – you have to work as though nobody is coming to save you.

2. **EVERYTHING IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY**

You are your savior, so start working because EVERYTHING IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY. You are your security, you are your medic, you are your rescuer.

3. **SAVE WHO NEEDS TO BE SAVED**

Politics & Legislation

"Live Free or Die" is the motto of the state of New Hampshire. Unfortunately, it is rapidly changing to the "Do As I Say or Die" state.

The New Hampshire House passed HB 1101, a Three Day Waiting Period Bill, to the Democrat controlled Senate on 18 February. It has a very good chance of being passed by the Senate.

The House is ready to pass a Universal Background Check for ALL commercial firearm sales. It has the same problem as the bill with the same title that Governor Sununu vetoed last session. Also, Senate Bill 677, which is a rehash of last years "Red Flag" law. This bill does away with:

- Your right to face and cross examine your accuser.

- "Beyond a reasonable doubt" standard and replaces it with "Preponderance of the evidence", a much lower burden of proof.
- Your right to examine witnesses against you.
- Your right to attend a hearing before a court order is issued.
- Your right to an appeal in a higher court.
- A crime actually being committed first and allows for the meaning of abuse to become a showing of an immediate and present danger of "harsh words" which could result in a protective order and a loss of your firearms.

Once again, we must rely on the Governor's common sense to stop

these infringements of our rights.

Why does this keep happening in our state? As stated above, the New Hampshire House and Senate are controlled by Democrats.

Many local elections will be held this month. Voting for candidates who believe in the Constitution of the State of New Hampshire and the United States Constitution has always been of utmost importance in my consideration before voting. Sadly, this seems to becoming an old fashioned idea. Well, I hope you consider being an Old Fogie like me and put the priorities of voting for Constitutionlists at the top of your list before casting your ballot. We need to keep our rights foremost and forever.
