


# Absent Companion - Rodney Brown








# Your Right to Defend Yourself?







These maps show where you can legally carry a concealed firearm if you have a Maine, New Hampshire, or Massachusetts License to Carry a Concealed Weapon.

USA: Alaska, Arizona, Arkansas, Idaho, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Maine, Montana, Mississippi, Missouri, New Hampshire, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Vermont, West Virginia, and Wyoming have "Permitless Carry". Anyone who can legally possess a firearm may carry it concealed in those states without a Permit or License. North Dakota has Permitless Carry for their Residents only.

ME: Anyone who can legally possess a firearm can carry it concealed in Maine under their Permitless Carry Law. Maine also honors Resident Licenses or Permits from Alaska, Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Iowa, Idaho, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Michigan, Missouri, Mississippi, New Hampshire, North Dakota, North Carolina, Nebraska, Ohio, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Tennessee, Utah, Virginia, and Wyoming. Maine will only honor resident permit/ licenses from the states they honor. When carrying under permitless carry, unless Military or Hon Disc Vet, you must be 21. If carrying with a permit/license Maine honors, you must be 18 or older.

NH: Anyone who can legally possess a firearm can carry it concealed in New Hampshire under their Permitless Carry Law. New Hampshire also honors Licenses from Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Michigan, Missouri, Mississippi, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Tennessee, Utah, Virginia, West Virginia, and Wyoming.

**MA:** Fascistchusetts doesn't honor Permits or Licenses from any other states at all.




