RIFLE LEAGUE

This is a free style event with an "any caliber/any action" (following all club range and safety rules) format. As opposed to competition scoring, the league is designed to set aside a time when members of all experience levels having an interest in riflery can meet to share experience and to gain expertise. There is a place for everyone from new shooters to bench rest experts. The summer is a busy season for most

COWBOY ACTION SHOOTING MATCHES

Howdy Folks!

Cowboy Action Shooting (CAS) is all about dressin' up like folks did in the Old West and shootin' guns that were commonly used back then.

The targets are steel plates, and they're pretty big and pretty close, so expert marksmanship is NOT required. We set up our matches so that every shooter, regardless of experience, can target. Winners every determined by just how quickly they hit those targets.

Our matches are pretty easy - we don't try to compete so much as have a good time. Havin' a good time, along with being SAFE, are two rules that we strictly enforce.

As far as dressin' up, we're not terribly formal about that, but dressin' up is half the fun! All you really need is pair of jeans, a long-sleeved shirt, a cowboy style hat, and boots. The only things that we really insist on are: No Baseball-style Caps, No Sneakers, No Short-Sleeve Shirts, and No Nylon, Web, or Velcro Gear. They just didn't have any of that stuff in the 1800s.

We use firearms that were available prior to 1899 - originals or replicas. You'll need two single-action six-guns. a lever-action rifle (in pistol caliber only), and a double-barrel or exposedhammer pump shotgun. If you don't have the right guns, don't worry, most of the regular shooters are willin' to lend firearms to new shooters that haven't got the proper ones, just so they can get the hang of it. That's how I got started in this – I didn't have any of the right equipment, but one of the regular cowhands loaned me

was hooked! A lot of us bring extra guns and ammo just in case someone shows up and wants to try this game on for size.

To shoot a match at CPF&G, you'll need about 60 rounds each of pistol and rifle ammo, and a 25-round box of shotgun shells. Both rifle and pistol ammo must be pistol caliber (.45 Colt, .44 Special, .38 Special, etc.) LEAD bullets only - no jacketed or rifle caliber ammo allowed - and all ammo should be mild field or target loads (it doesn't take much to make a steel plate go "Ding!" from 25 feet away). Shotshells must be size 7 ½ or smaller LEAD shot. If you're borrowin' guns from someone, you can probably borrow some ammo as well.

Our matches are divided into six "Stages". Each stage is a different course of fire, and each stage has a "Scenario" to go with it. The scenario is a short storyline that explains why each stage is set up the way it is. A typical scenario might start out with "You're in the saloon playin' poker when in walk two hombres with fire in their eyes..."

We shoot three stages, break for lunch, then shoot three more stages.

The stages and scenarios are different for each match. They're posted in advance on Piney Woods' website. www.pineywoodsplace.com/cpfgcas.ht ml. There are also links on that page that lead to all kinds of information about this game and how we play it here at CPF&G. Results are posted in the same place within a day or two after the match.

This year we'll be hosting six CAS matches at CPF&G. We held our first one on April 12th, when we had "The Great Easter Bunny Hunt". Our remaining 2009 matches will be held on May 10th (our famous "All Ladies Shoot Free" Mother's Day Match), June 14th, August 9th, September 20th,

and October 11th. Match Registration is from 10:30 to 11:45, followed by a mandatory safety meeting. The actual match starts at high noon, and we're usually done by 4:30. As far as cost goes: it's \$5.00 for CPF&G Members, \$10.00 for non-members, and Juniors (under 16) shoot FREE.

We feel our match is the perfect place to come out and experience what CAS is all about. Once you've tried it you'll be hooked! The folks here are a friendly bunch and no matter what your skill level you're welcome to come join us! POLITICAL NOTES

Note: With everything going on in Washington these days I will try and focus on firearms issues. It will not be easy!

Federal: Since the recent shootings in several states the media and the antigun groups have been going full blast with their tirades about more gun control. The ABC news program 20/20 ran a show with a hidden camera at a gun show. Purchases were made without background checks and a former BATF agent said all you needed was the money to buy any item.

Most of us are very familiar with the Federal law requiring NICS checks

of any gun sales by licensed dealers. Private gun sales are a different matter. This is what they are focusing on as the "Gun show Loophole." What they were trying to do was to convince people that licensed dealers will sell to anyone with the right amount of money.

Once again the anti-gun groups will use any tragedy perpetrated by madmen to advance their agenda on gun registration/confiscation.

New Hampshire: Things in the Granite State are happening very fast. HB398 is a bill to repeal RSA 644:13 which is the section of the law prohibiting firearms use in a "compact area" of a town. People who have had backyard ranges on their own property for years can no longer use them because of this law. With the population explosion in our state it had to happen.

Special Notice: The Supreme Judicial Court of the State of New Hampshire has ruled in our favor in regards to the accusations of Sara Realty, LLC. We fought these accusations with RSA 159-B: 2, this is the law that protects shooting ranges from nuisance claims for noise. Unfortunately what the NHSJC did not do is rule on the constitutionality of the RSA. This door was left open for possible rehearing under Rule 22. The ruling is good news. The fact that the door was left open to challenge the RSA is very troubling and should be to all gun-owners in the state.


