### **Political Concerns**

NH House Bill 1635 - This legislation would infringe upon our Second Amendment rights by outlawing the possession of firearms in state or town buildings, including state-operated rest areas, the university system/community college system of NH, the State House complex, etc. Enactment of HB 1635 would create victim zones by disarming potential crime victims. Moreover, because posting of prohibited premises would be optional, a person could enter into a prohibited property or place unknowingly and become a felon for life

The House Criminal Justice and Public Safety Committee will consider this bill. (Source: NRA/ILA)

The US House of Representatives passed HR 3326, the Department of Defense Appropriations Act of 2010. There is a rider attached to this bill to protect M-1 carbines, M-1 Garands, M-14s, .22 caliber rifles, and others from being destroyed. The language also included a prohibition on the destruction of small arms ammunition and components, passed in response to

the short-lived concern over the destruction of spent brass casings. A small win for the shooting community but an important one in my opinion. (Source: NRA)

The US Supreme Court agreed to hear the landmark Second Amendment case of McDonald v. Chicago. The case will address the application of the Second Amendment to the states through either the Due Process clause or the Privileges or Immunities clause of the Fourteenth Amendment. This case would guarantee the application of the Second Amendment through out the fifty states and US possessions as adjudicated by the Supreme Court.

I would encourage all of our members who do not belong to the NRA to consider joining this organization as soon as possible. You have heard me many times at the club meetings and club events touting the NRA. Playing politics is a very expensive endeavor and having the NRA playing politics in Washington, DC, for us may be the only reason we still have our firearms.

### **CMP MATCHES**

The 2010 CMP (Civilian Marksmanship Program) season at Country Pond will begin on Saturday, 27 March. The first match will be a semi-auto shoot and will start at 09:30. We hope to be finished by 11:30.

For this match, any military semi-auto firearm, (Garand, SKS, AK-47, AR-15, etc.) that is still in the configuration of an unmodified service rifle - no scopes, red-dots, etc - may be used. The fee to shoot is \$10.00, which covers the cost of the five targets, one for practice and four for score. If you shoot a 30.06 and would like to buy ammunition for the match, there will be some available to competitors: 60 rounds for \$20.00. All ammo bought at the match must be used at the match. If your rifle isn't chambered for 30.06, you'll need to provide your own ammunition.

The course of fire is designed to test the shooter's skill and concentration when shooting at a series of targets set up 100 yards away. Each shooter will have the opportunity to fire up to ten rounds for sighting in and practice before the first string is fired for score.

String #1 - 10 rounds in 10 minutes
The first string has each shooter
starting off with ten rounds, loading
each round singly. This is shot "off
hand"; that is, standing up to shoot at
the target. No slings may be used.

String #2 - 10 rounds in 60 seconds Next, the shooter fires from either a kneeling or sitting position, using two magazines: one loaded with two rounds, the other with eight. Rifles with a magazine round limit of five may use two 5-round magazines.

String #3 - 10 rounds in 70 seconds The third target is shot from a prone position. Again, there must be a magazine reload.

String #4 - 20 rounds in 20 minutes The last string is also fired from the prone position, loading a single round each time.

For bolt-action rifle shoots, the course of fire is the same, except that the time limit for the sitting/kneeling rapid fire string is 70 seconds and the prone rapid fire string is 80 seconds.

Firearms up to \$600: \$10 Firearms \$601 & up: \$15 Ammo & Accessories: 5% All Transfers: \$10

Members who order guns themselves, to be delivered to the Club, must require the sender to include an invoice or other form describing the firearms' make, model, caliber, serial number, and name of sender. A form for this purpose is available at the club. If this data is not included, the firearm will be returned to the sender, and a \$10.00 charge will be assessed to the Member.

Earl Tibbetts will be at the clubhouse Saturdays, from 11:00 to 13:00, for any firearms transactions.

Notice: There will be an additional \$20.00 charge for items shipped to the Club via FED/EX. Choose UPS or the US Postal Service instead.

### Posters & Flyers

We've noticed a lot of unauthorized posters and flyers appearing around the club lately. The CPF&G Club Standing Rules specifically prohibit this, except on the bulletin boards.

"No one shall post any sign or notice pertaining to Club information, rules, customs, instructions, warnings, or prohibitions on Club property without prior approval of the Board of Directors. All signs or notices shall have "Per order of the Board of Directors" displayed across the bottom of the sign or notice. This rule shall not apply to "For Sale" or "Services Offered" postings, obituaries, or other notices of a personal nature that may be posted on Club bulletin boards."
