The mission of GSSG is to promote, organize & effectively develop physical challenges, as they relate to the 50+ population of the State of New Hampshire, undertake related activities benefiting the well being of senior

adults as appropriate, and focusing on the development of active & healthy lifestyles. The mission is accomplished by encouraging fitness and by providing athletic competition in a variety of sports, clinics and creative pursuits.

GSSG holds annual State Games for athletes of all abilities. There are 16 different competitive sports with over 50 events held at various venues in a central location. Sports include



Archery, Badminton, Basketball, Bowling, Bullseye Pistol, Cycling, Golf, Horseshoes, Racewalk, Racquetball,

Road Race, Shuffleboard, Swimming, Table Tennis, Tennis, and Track & Field. The 23rd Granite State Senior Games are scheduled for Saturday, 17 July to Sunday, 29 August 2010.

The Archery event will be held on 1 August at Pioneer Sportsmen in Dunbarton, NH, rain or shine. Shooters will score and paste targets. Current NRA conventional rules shall govern. The Bullseye Pistol event will also be held at Pioneer Sportsmen on 14 August.


On Monday May 10, 2010, GONH held the annual LFO Day, hosted by Sunset Mountain Fish and Game Club in Canterbury, NH.

There were over 75 attendees, including 30 legislators, their families, and guests. The goal was to inform and educate New Hampshire elected officials about the vast variety of firearms and their many uses, both sporting and self defense, and to dispel the many myths the media broadcasts as facts, lacking even a cursory investigation, which makes many wonder what ever happened to journalistic integrity.

Shooting disciplines represented were Cowboy Action, Pistol & Revolver, Service Rifle, Long Range Precision Rifle, Shotgun, Hunting Rifle, Thompson Semi-Automatic, Rimfire Rifle, Black Powder, and African Hunting Rifles. There were demonstrations of full auto 50 caliber, 30 caliber and M16 rifle.

Any experienced shooter would be amazed at how much time was spent explaining the difference between automatic and semiautomatic firearms, proving what many shooters already know; that the misinformed must be educated to the truth about firearms or we are going to lose the battle for our 2nd Amendment rights.





CPF&G Club FFL Fees & Rules

Firearms up to \$600: \$10 Firearms \$601 & up: \$15 Ammo & Accessories: 5% All Transfers: \$10

Members who order guns themselves, to be delivered to the Club, must require the sender to include an invoice or other form describing the firearms' make, model, caliber, serial number, and name of sender. A form for this purpose is available at the club. If this data is not included, the firearm will be returned to the sender, and a \$10.00 charge will be assessed to the Member.

Earl Tibbetts will be at the clubhouse Saturdays, from 11:00 to 13:00, for any firearms orders or transactions.

Notice: There will be an additional \$20.00 charge for items shipped to the Club via FED/EX. Choose UPS or the US Postal Service instead.
