Right to Carry?

The map below shows where you can legally carry a concealed firearm if you have any New Hampshire License to Carry (green states), where you can legally carry only if you have a resident NH LTC (yellow states), and where you can't at all (gray states).



NH honors resident licenses from AK, AL, AZ, CO, FL, GA, ID, IN, KY, LA, MI, MO, MS, NC, ND, OK, PA, TN, UT, and WY, but no non-resident licenses.

This map shows the same data if you have a Massachusetts Class A LTC.



Massachusetts doesn't honor any other states' licenses at all. (Why are we not surprised?)
