Politics & Legislation

U.S. Senator Jerry Moran (R-KS) has introduced legislation that would stop the Obama administration from using the United Nations to eliminate our gun rights. S.2205, the Second Amendment Sovereignty Act of 2012, will cut off taxpayer funding for the United Nations Arms Trade Treaty, which is now being negotiated to restrict the Second Amendment rights of American citizens.

In a reversal of long-standing policy, Secretary of State Hillary Rodham Clinton has announced that the United States will support and participate in negotiating this UN Arms Trade Treaty, which will be finalized this year. This treaty would regulate the domestic manufacture, possession, and purchase of civilian firearms and ammunition, in direct conflict with the rights of American citizens under the Second Amendment.

The bill provides that no funds may be spent to help negotiate a United Nations Arms Trade Treaty, or to restrict in any way the rights of United States citizens under the Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States, or to otherwise regulate domestic manufacture, assembly, possession, use, transfer, or purchase of firearms, ammunition, or related items – including small arms, light weapons, or related materials.

We all know Barack Obama has done everything he can to destroy our Second Amendment rights, but what is so pernicious about this treaty is its cowardly, backdoor attempt to impose massive restrictions on America's gun rights without signaling their intentions. This is why negotiations are being held behind closed doors, so no one can know with certainty, all the gun control proposals in the treaty, until it's too late to react.

Passage of the Moran bill is critical because S.2205 will prevent Hillary Clinton and Barack Obama form succeeding in their efforts to negotiate away our gun rights.

Your Right to Defend Yourself?

These maps show where you can legally carry a concealed firearm if you have a New Hampshire, Massachusetts, or Maine License to Carry a Concealed Weapon.

New Hampshire honors <u>Resident</u> Licenses from Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Louisiana, Michigan, Missouri, Mississippi, North Carolina, North Dakota, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Utah, and Wyoming. New Hampshire does not honor Non-Resident Permits or Licenses. You must be a resident of the state they honor for your permit to be valid in New Hampshire.

Massachusetts doesn't honor any other states' licenses at all.

Like New Hampshire, Maine only honors <u>Resident</u> Licenses or Permits, and only from Arkansas, Delaware, Louisiana, Michigan, North Dakota, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, and Wyoming.




