Politics & Legislation

Let's take a look at what this group wants for New Hampshire in relation to firearms.

- Require eye examinations for firearm purchases and Concealed Carry Licenses.
- Require a firearm safety course for issuance and renewal of CCLs and firearms acquisitions.
- Require mental health information to be included in background checks.
- Make the criteria for background checks for issuance and renewal of CCLs and gun purchases effective and identical so as to achieve the same goals.
- Background checks will include searches of all pertinent databases.
- All firearms purchases will now require background checks.
- Police chiefs are now required to issue CCLs. This should be changed to licenses can only be issued for a valid reason.
- Registration of handguns should now be required in New Hampshire.
- All acquisitions of firearms after a certain date will require a background check, an eye examination and firearms safety course certificate.
- Since NH and Maine are a source for firearms used in the drug trade (?), there should be a limit to the number of firearms an individual may purchase over time.
- A ban on the sale or transfer of semi-auto rifles that accept high capacity magazines.
- A ban on the sale or transfer of high capacity magazines modeled after the one proposed at the federal level.
- A limit on the quantity and types of ammo an individual may possess with the exceptions for licensed dealers and law enforcement.
- A ban on carrying firearms in public buildings with exceptions for law enforcement, etc.
- A ban on the possession of firearms by persons who have their driver's license revoked for cause. This info will be entered into the background check info database.
- A ban on the possession of firearms by persons who have substance abuse convictions. (Already a felony subject to firearm restriction)
- A ban on the possession of firearms by persons who have been adjudged to be mentally incompetent or a danger to themselves or others. This info will be entered into the background check info database.

(Now the real kick in the head)

- Since so many gun owners are IRRESPONSIBLE, gun owners should be required to carry LIABILITY INSURANCE.
- Repeal of Stand Your Ground (law) in New Hampshire. (Information source: Firearms & Freedom – the official newsletter of GONH, Inc.)

Yes folks, we have our own anti-gun zealots who have no idea about the legal use, the safe use, and the intelligent use of firearms. They live and breathe (and crawl in my opinion) in our great state. I would like to know how many of these people were born and raised in the Granite State.

The pro-gun legislation introduce by Rep JR Hoell (R), HB 1264, was decimated in committee and turned into an act establishing a commission to study the impact of firearms violence, to explore options to strengthen the background check system for firearms sales, and to consider measures to promote firearms safety. This is the opposite of the intent of Rep Hoell's proposed legislation.

I have mentioned in previous articles the schemes and tricks that go on under the gold dome in Concord. This is a fine example of how some of our legislators who are in positions of power further their agendas and stop the efforts of legislators who believe in our state constitution and our right to keep and bear arms.

Update 03/19/14: HB1264 was tabled. Unfortunately the bill is not dead. More to come.

Some good news: GONH President Mitch Kopacz and other GONH officers have invested many hours working with NH Senators to revamp SB 244. The bill is now something the firearms community should find favor with.

SB 244 an act establishing a procedure for the annulment of a mental health record and establishing a commission to study mental health and firearms.

Part one: Annulment of mental health records in the National Instant Criminal Background Check System. If we can get this accepted into state law a person will be able to expunge their records for mental health in the state. Unfortunately it can only recommend that the federal records under NICS be changed. We cannot demand the feds do anything. Surprised?

Part two: Commission to study mental health and firearms. The commission shall study any issue related to the NICS and the federal statutes and rules governing NICS, including, but not limited to, providing access to an attorney prior to the inclusion of a person's information in NICS and the liability of New Hampshire's firearms businesses under the state's existing background check reporting requirements. Included on the commission will be the NRA, GONH, NHFC, PGNH,

Second Amendment Sisters, NSSF, NH Wildlife Federation, and others.

If this bill passes AS WRITTEN we have a chance for people to correct errors in their records.

Don't forget tax day (April 15th) is rapidly approaching. I would recommend that all firearms owners not give the IRS an excuse to scrutinize how and what you do. We as gun owners have enough government intervention in our lives.

Members Monthly Meeting 17 APRIL 19:00

Outdoor Range Rule Clarification

A question was raised at the February Monthly Meeting regarding the practice of leaving guns on the shooting bench while people are downrange.

CPF&G Range Rule D-4 states:

When not in use, all firearms must be unloaded and racked with actions open, holstered, or cased.

"In use" means you're shooting the gun. That means when you're not actually shooting a firearm, it must be UNLOADED and either RACKED, CASED, or HOLSTERED. If racked, the action must be open.

Any gun left unattended and uncased on a shooting bench, even if open and empty, does not comply with this rule. There is no option to leave any gun on a shooting bench, unless it is cased or holstered.

The "unloaded" provision of this rule does not apply to personal defense firearms that remain securely holstered.

Note that range safety procedures followed at organized events may vary from the above. Typically, they will follow the Club's "Make the Line Safe" procedure:

- 1. Actions open
- 2. Magazines out
- 3. Gun placed on the table, positioned so that the RO can see that it's empty.

 Semi-autos = lying on left side, positioned so the mag well can be seen into

 Double-Action Revolvers = on right side, cylinder open

 Single-Action Revolvers = on left side, loading gate open
- 4. Step back behind the Yellow Safety Line
- 5. No one touches any firearms, including those racked, cased, or holstered.

Organized event rules and procedures are determined by the individual event director.


