Country Pond Fish & Game Club Range Safety Officer Program

Country Pond Fish & Game Club is launching an Authorized Club Range Safety Officer Program.

The motto of our program is:

BE NICE

STAY CALM

BE PROFESSIONAL

NEVER LOSE YOUR COOL



While our Program will embrace the principles espoused in the NRA Range Safety Officer Course, it is being tailored towards issues and situations that are specifically CPF&G Club oriented. We have had quite a few situations that could have benefited from the presence of a Range Officer in the past, and we would like to ensure that these issues are covered in the future.

The training course will address the following:

- ★ NRA firearm and range safety rules
- ★ CPF&G Club specific Range Rules
- ★ Range Safety Violations
- ★ The RSO authority and limits thereof
- ★ The desired methods and degrees of intervention with emphasis on securing range safety
- ★ Possible scenarios and the desired RSO action in cases of escalation or inappropriate reactions
- ★ The appropriate decisions and the proper techniques required in rendering an unsafe situation safe or manageable, i.e. squib loads, malfunctioning firearms, lack of member expertise, etc.
- ★ Proper procedure for issuing, documenting, and processing safety citations

There are a number of prerequisites to join the Program. The Club Range Safety Officer (RSO) candidate must:

- ★ be able to demonstrate a basic knowledge of firearms;
- ★ be an active CPF&G Club Member for a minimum of one year;
- ★ have passed the NRA Range Safety Officer Course (This course is likely to be offered in the near future at CPF&G Club for those who are interested in the Club Program, but have not had an opportunity to take the NRA Course);
- ★ be interviewed and vetted by the Range Safety Committee;
- ★ agree to complete the Club Range Safety Officer Training Program;
- ★ agree to attend at least one Club Orientation Session;
- ★ agree to attend at least three of the four quarterly scheduled Range Safety meetings annually;
- ★ agree to act as RSO at certain scheduled Club events;
- ★ agree to attend but not necessarily participate in at least one session of every Club sanctioned shooting event, so as to become familiar with how different events are conducted. These events include, but are not limited to, Archery League, Bowling Pin Shoots, Bullseye Pistol League (rimfire or centerfire), CMP, Cowboy Action Shooting, Rifle League, Steel Plate Shoots, and Trap Shooting; and
- ★ be willing and able to escalate intervention, if necessary, from low key constructive & instructive to confrontational & authoritative.





The United Nations has been quietly working on their agenda to ban civilian use and ownership of firearms around the world, with special emphasis on the United States and our rights to self-defense and firearm ownership. These elitists have deemed, in their infinite wisdom, that no one has a right to self-defense, because it may deny the right of the perpetrators of criminal activity their rights. On the home front: NH Governor Hassan and her minions at the state Department of Safety have been up to some odious activity. The NH Firearms Coalition is criticizing changes made to the state Concealed Carry License (CCL) application form without the input of the legislature or public comment. The NHFC released a statement that "the changes would invite rogue police chiefs to deny permits (licenses) for flimsy, insubstantial reasons."

The state Department of Safety has gotten numerous calls and emails from angry gun owners. Earl Sweeney, assistant commissioner of safety, who approved the new form, said one change was made on the advice of the Attorney General's Office after a NH Supreme Court ruling in May. Sweeney said he didn't anticipate the changes would cause such a firestorm. He pledged to work with gun rights advocates to fix the problem. (Source NHFC and NH Sunday News 8/17/2014)





There are three new questions on the form that are vague and could be misinterpreted by applicants, causing delays and possible denial in the licensing process. Commissioner Sweeney said he believes the language





of the gun license law was intentionally vague "Because you can't predict every single situation that might arise and so I think it does give them some flexibility."

Rep. Hoell said he thinks "suitable person" should be defined in the law, and he plans to propose legislation to do so.

Shooting Steel: Centerfire Pistol Plates

The Centerfire Pistol Plate Shoot is the newest event for both members and guests hosted by Country Pond Fish and Game Club. Anyone who has had the opportunity to attend our annual Turkey Shoot could see that this was one of the most popular events on that day. Unfortunately, you could only shoot them on that day... until now!

In March 2014, the Board of Directors gave their approval to add the Centerfire Pistol Plate Shoot to the long list of Club events that are open to both members and the public.

For anyone looking to shoot something besides paper targets, this may be just what you are looking for. While you don't need to be a competitive pistol shooter, you need to be proficient at handling and shooting your firearm in a safe manner. To compete all you need is your pistol, at least two magazines and 36 rounds of ammo. Six 8-inch plates are set on a rack 25 feet from the firing line. At the buzzer you simply knock over those six plates with the six rounds loaded in your magazine.

The timer will record the shots down to the hundredths of seconds. You will shoot this rack a total of six times and your final score will be your fastest five out of six racks. The key to success is accuracy before speed. It is fairly easy to take six shots in six seconds or less but the two second penalty for each miss can easily double your time.

We shoot multiple relays so if you have more than one gun to use, or if you just want to "better your time", bring lots of ammo, because once you try this you won't want to stop.

In the five months since we began the Centerfire Pistol Plate Shoot, the response from the participants has been overwhelmingly positive. It is a fun, safe, and challenging shoot that you should definitely add to your list of "Things To Try" at Country Pond Fish and Game Club.
