CPF&G Club Outdoor Range Rule Changes

(effective 2 July 2015)

At the July Board of Directors Meeting, a motion was made and seconded to change the Club Range Rules pertaining to the Outdoor Range, to allow a greater variety of approved targets. After discussion, the motion passed, and Range Rules D-8 thru D-11 and an Appendix with diagrams to illustrate the rules were added:

 Regardless of type, all targets must be positioned in the area shown in Figure A (see Appendix), at the 25, 50, or 100 yd berms only.

Approved targets include:

- (1) paper targets attached to Club target frame backers;
- (2) targets attached to shooter supplied target supports of similar size and construction to Club frames (See Rule D-11). These may include paper targets, balloons, empty cans, empty plastic bottles, or other items that will allow a bullet to easily pass thru without being deflected in any way:
- (3) targets used in Club sanctioned events; or
- targets as specified below, used solely in the manner described.

STEEL PLATES

Steel plate targets may not be rigidly mounted; they must be free to swing on impact. Plates must be supported in such a way that the target face is initially angled downward by no less than 10°. Steel plates must be placed in the area shown in Figure A, at the 100 yd berm for any rifle caliber shooting, or at the 50 or 100 yd berms for pistol caliber shooting. Steel Plate targets may not be used at the 25 yd berm.

COMMERCIAL REACTIVE RESETTING STEEL TARGETS Targets similar to those shown in Figures Bl to B4 (see Appendix), positioned as shown in Figure A, are approved for use at the 25, 50, and 100 yd berms.

- Glass items, pressurized containers, and targets constructed of any material that shatters on impact, or that cannot be easily and completely removed from the Range after being shot, are specifically prohibited.
- Shooters shall personally police and remove all target debris before leaving the range. If you bring it in, you must take it out.
- 11. Shooter supplied target supports, referenced in Section D-8 (2) above, must be constructed of wood and indelibly marked with the name and membership number of the shooter. Any shooter constructed target support system may make use of the fixed Club target frame bases, but Club target bases shall not be moved or modified in any way.

The above changes were made to give Club Members more latitude in their target choices, hopefully adding more of a "fun factor" to their shooting activities. However, it should be noted that failure to adhere to the above restrictions, or failure to remove all target debris, would likely result in a rapid return to the old "paper targets only" rules.

LET'S KEEP THE RANGE NEAT.

At the same Meeting, a proposal was submitted to end the Sunday 10:00 to 12:00 closures of the Outdoor Range. The motion was seconded and was passed after discussion.

Range Rule A-3, which previously read:

The Outdoor Rifle/Pistol Range is open to Members from 09:00 to one-half hour after sunset.
 Exceptions: Sundays from 10:00 to 12:00 for Club Membership Tours and Trap, all day on Thanksgiving and Christmas, and periodically for Club sanctioned events, e.g. Outdoor Pin Shoots, Cowboy Action Shooting Matches, and .22 Rimfire Plate Shoots.

has been changed to remove:

"Sundays from 10:00 to 12:00 for Club Membership Tours and Trap," resulting in:

The Outdoor Rifle/Pistol Range is open to Members from 09:00 to one-half hour after sunset.
 Exceptions: All day on Thanksgiving and Christmas, and periodically for Club sanctioned events, e.g. Outdoor Pin Shoots, Cowboy Action Shooting Matches, and .22 Rimfire Plate Shoots.





According to the UN's Department of Disarmament Affairs, it's all under the guise of combating Insurgents, armed




