


NH Governor Hassan signed SB522, a bill that requires a criminal conviction before the government can forfeit property from citizens. Some of the admirable reforms in this new law protect innocent property owners and cure several constitutional deficiencies in NH's forfeiture laws. SB522 raises the standard of proof required to forfeit property to "clear and convincing evidence" from the lower "preponderance of evidence." It also shifts the burden of proof from innocent third-party property owners onto the state, ensuring the presumption of innocence. 
