



Politics & Legislation

NH Governor Hassan signed SB522, a bill that requires a criminal conviction before the government can forfeit property from citizens. Some of the admirable reforms in this new law protect innocent property owners and cure several constitutional deficiencies in NH's forfeiture laws. SB522 raises the standard of proof required to forfeit property to "clear and convincing evidence" from the lower "preponderance of evidence." It also shifts the burden of proof from innocent third-party property owners onto the state, ensuring the presumption of innocence. On the other hand: Governor Hassan has found WMDs in Newington, NH! Actually, people are making what Sen. Jeanne Shaheen called "weapons of war" in Exeter and Dover and they have a massive training camp set up in Epping where they teach people from all over the world how to use them.

That might be shocking, but the real scandal is that Governor Hassan has been funneling taxpayer money to train these merchants of death for years.

Displaying the in-depth policy expertise we've come to expect from the Democratic governor as she campaigns for the US Senate, Hassan justified her support for an "assault weapons" ban by saying that Orlando terrorist Omar Mateen "got a weapon of mass destruction." Mateen used a SIG MCX, made in NH by workers trained with grants supplied by Hassan. Note to our illustrious governor – nearly a third of US law enforcement carries SIG guns. If you don't believe this can happen in our country, it already has. Thousands of veterans returning from combat duty areas who asked for counseling for depression have had their firearms confiscated and have no legal recourse to regain their firearms or their Second Amendment rights.

Congratulations to Donald Trump for his nomination as the GOP presidential candidate. Remember if you do not vote in the coming election you are electing Hillary. She will have at least 2 if not 3 chances to nominate left wing liberals to the Supreme Court. Enough said.


