### Changes to the Club Constitution and Bylaws

The changes noted below were voted upon and approved at the October Monthly Meeting.

The full text of the Club Constitution and Bylaws is available online, at http://www.cpfgc.com/laws\_rules.html

Current Articles VIII thru XVI were renumbered as VIII thru XVII, in order to allow a new Article VIII to be added:

Article VIII: Budget Committee

- 8.1 The Club Budget Committee shall consist of five (5) Club Members, each of whom shall have been a Club Member in good standing for not less than two (2) years.
- 8.2 The Committee Chair shall be the Club Treasurer.
- 8.3 Members of the Committee shall be selected by the Committee Chair, subject to approval of the Board of Directors.
- 8.4 Except for the Club Treasurer, in order to avoid any conflict of interest, Members of the Board of Directors shall not serve on the Budget Committee.
- 8.5 Except as noted in Chapter 2, Article 7.4, all requests for Club funds, to be used in the establishment or furtherance of any Club Event or Activity, shall be submitted directly to the Budget Committee, using whatever forms or procedures as the Committee shall establish.
  - 8.51 The Budget Committee shall review all such requests to establish the effects on the Club as a whole, taking into account the number of Club Members that would be favorably or adversely affected by the request.
  - 8.52 The Committee shall either
    - a. deny the request;
    - b. modify the request and return it to the requestor for review; or
    - c. approve the request and forward its recommendation to the Board of Directors or the Membership for action thereon.
- 8.6 In the event that a request is denied by the Budget Committee, the requestor may appeal the decision to the Membership at a subsequent monthly Meeting.
  - 8.61 Any Appeal must be submitted in writing to the Club Secretary, at least ten (10) days prior to the Meeting, so as to allow it to be placed on the Meeting Agenda.
  - 8.62 Overriding the Budget Committee's denial shall require a two-thirds (2/3) majority of Members present.

This Article shall become effective at such point that the Budget Committee is firmly established and able to act as a committee.



#### Bump Stock mania has arrived. Thanks to a deranged individual in Las Vegas (of all places) we now have the anti-




## **Politics & Legislation**

The problem with the ban on a firearm accessory is it could and would be a slippery slope for many more bans on any item that would make the firearm more efficient. Remember the Clinton assault weapons ban of a few years ago?

Bump stocks were invented and designed for shooters with prosthetic arms and hands so they could enjoy the shooting sports. Bipods aid the long distant shooter. Pistol grips give the shooter better control of a semiauto. The list of accessories that aid the everyday law-abiding citizen to be a better shooter would be vulnerable to these bans in the future, if some lunatic has a firearm equipped with any of these and commits a horrendous act.
