New Hampshire:

HB 1313 – Relative to prohibitions on carrying a loaded firearm on an OHRV or snowmohile

Although we are a constitutional carry state, most are unaware that exercising that right while on an off-road vehicle or snowmobile is prohibited by law. This bill is an attempt to repeal RSA 215-A:20, relative to the prohibition on carrying a loaded firearm on an OHRV, and RSA 215-C:35, relative to the prohibition on carrying a loaded firearm on a snowmobile. It should come as no surprise that NH Fish & Game opposes the repeal of these prohibitions.

HB 1406- Relative to concealed carry licenses and evidence of domicile for voting purposes.


This bill adds a concealed carry license to the list of acceptable forms of proof of domicile for voting purposes, makes a concealed carry license valid for 3 years (currently good for 5 years), and renders a resident's concealed carry license invalid 30 days after he or she relocates to a new city or town (currently license is valid anywhere in the state until expiration date of license). You will still need a valid government photo ID to vote. This is a backdoor effort to change concealed carry licenses in an adverse way.

HB 1438 – Relative to residential leases including provisions prohibiting tenants from possessing firearms, explosives, or ammunition within the premises.

This bill allows for rental and lease agreements for residential property to include a clause prohibiting tenants from possessing firearms, explosives, or ammunition within the premises. The problem with this bill is that the prohibition does not have to be disclosed prominently. If you have ever been a renter with a lease agreement, not reading the fine print can get you into trouble, including having to move again.

Politics & Legislation

Amend RSA 31:39 to read as follows: "(n) Regulating noise, provided that such bylaw requires a specified decibel level which may vary according to the time of day, that the decibel level be determined by a person qualified to use a decibel meter, and that any law enforcement action shall be taken only as the results of a complaint." This bill was proposed with motorcycles in mind, but those of us involved with what Country Pond went through about noise abatement know this is a





slippery slope we do not want to have to go down again.

SB 500 – An act amending references to firearms terminology.

This Senate bill started out as something most state firearms organization could support. The snag came with the definition of a firearm. In this bill the sponsors are insisting the state definition of a firearm be replaced with "shall have the meaning set forth in 18 U.S.C section 921". The problem with this is if the federal definition changes, we must change the state definition. Not a good idea.

Centerfire Pistol League

This year, the Country Pond Fish & Game Club Centerfire Pistol League, open to all members, starts on 7 February and finishes on 28 March. The league is at the same time as the

rimfire league - Wednesdays from 1700 to 2000. It will convene for seven nights with the last session this year on March 28. The last night is "Fun Shoot" with pizza and awards. However there will be no shooting on the Wednesday night of the rimfire banquet which is not yet scheduled.

Three targets are shot each night; slow, timed, and rapid. The times - 10 minutes for slow fire, 20 sec for each five shot string for timed fire - are the same as for the Rimfire League. However, we have always done what we call a "modified" rapid fire – using 20 seconds for that as well as for timed fire

As far as firearms are concerned, we

have few restrictions. If you want to use a different one each week that is fine. Changing firearms during a session however it not allowed. Finally, Club rules regarding caliber sizes that are allowed obviously apply.

It is a participant's choice as to whether they shoot one or two handed, and this is not tracked.

The last night is a "fun night" and no scores are kept. We traditionally do different activities like shooting at backward targets, small stickers on regular targets and things like that. Any ideas that participants have in this regard would be welcome. We also do pizza on the last night and have some awards. Last year we awarded .22 and 9mm ammo for high average in the various categories – Slow Fire, Timed Fire, Rapid Fire, and Overall Average. We did this for optical sights and iron sights as separate categories.

We will again use the spreadsheet that Piney put together. With that spreadsheet, results will be posted on our website instead of being sent by email. I also want to adopt the same rule that the rimfire league did – basically if you are shooting twice don't sign up for consecutive matches. Finally, unlike the Rimfire League we will not have teams or calculated handicaps. We will not be having a separate meeting this year but will just have a general discussion on our first night. This year Andy Gaunt will be helping out with the league. It is great


