Legislative Service Requests (LSR) have been filed at the State House. It should be no surprise to anyone that some of them are quite dubious.

2020-2001 HB Title: Imposing a ban on assault weapons in NH. Sponsor: (Prime) Katherine Rogers.

2020-2002 HB Title: Requiring a background check for commercial firearms sales. Sponsor: (Prime) Katherine Rogers

2020-2003 HB Title: Imposing a waiting period between the purchase and delivery of a firearm. Sponsor Katherine Rogers.

Anybody else see a pattern here? These were the first three LSRs recorded.

2020-2015 HB Title: Relative to the disposition of old weapons. Sponsor: (Prime) Donovan Fenton.

Until we see the language of this bill it is in question.

2020-2060 HB Title: Relative to the possession of firearms on school property. Sponsor: (Prime) Mary Heath.

2020-2062 HB Title: Relative to the discharge of a firearm in the compact part of a city or town. Sponsor (Prime) David Doherty.

2020-2127 HB Title: Relative to the annulment of misdemeanor domestic violence offenses. Sponsor (Prime) Daryl Abbas.

2020-2144 HB Title: Prohibiting the manufacture, sale, transfer, and possession of large capacity ammunition feeding devices. Sponsor: (Prime) Casey Conley.

2020-2150 HB Title: Repealing limited liability for manufacturers, distributors, dealers or importers of firearms or ammunition. Sponsor: (Prime) Andrew Bouldin.

2020-2231 HB Title: Relative to authorizing the state to set higher environmental standards then those established in federal law. Sponsor: (Prime) Robert Backus.

More restrictions on the use of lead in ammunition and fishing equipment? We need to see the language on this one.

2020-2416 HB Title: Establishing a protective order for vulnerable adults. Sponsor: (Prime) Robert Cushing.

Politics & Legislation

Depending how this bill is worded will determine if it is a threat or not.

2020-2553 HB Title: Establishing a committee to study firearms incidents involving children with access to unsecured firearms. Sponsor: (Prime) David Meuse.

This could be a bottomless pit for firearm owners depending on the final wording. Any time they "study" something scares the hell out of me! 2020-2554 HB Title: Requiring a locking

2020-2554 HB Litle: Requiring a locking safety device be provided for commercial firearm sales and transfers. Sponsor: (Prime) David Meuse.

Anybody who has purchased a firearm in the past ten years knows that this is already in effect.

2020-2687 HB Title: Relative to voluntarily surrendered firearms. Sponsor: (Prime) Robert Cushing.

The wording on this one will need to be scrutinized very carefully when the final version comes out.





2020-2689 HB Title: Establishing a safari hunting license for hunting certain exotic game. Sponsor: Prime Robert Cushing.
Anybody ever been on a NH safari? We need to talk!

2020-2707 HB Title: Relative to emergency threat orders. Sponsor: (Prime) David Luneau. Another "Red Flag" herring.

House Bill 687-FN was retained from the last session. An act relative to extreme risk protection orders. This bill has at least twelve sponsors. This is the Red Flag bill sent to committee last session to keep it from being veto by Governor Sununu.

The 2020 session starts in January and it is going to be another interesting one. If you do not pay attention to what is going on in a Presidential election year don't be surprised if they come knocking at your door in 2021 to confiscate your firearms for your own protection. Ever vigilant, ever prepared.
