 - a. Rimfire rifles or carbines firing .22 Short, .22 Long, or .22 Long Rifle ammunition.
 - b. Centerfire rifles or carbines firing .38 Special or 9x19mm ammunition.


Report: Senator Elizabeth Warren's campaign for president.

Senator Warren wants to raise the taxes on firearms manufacturers, up to 30% on guns and 50% on ammunition, according to her published agenda, to bring in new federal revenue that we can used for gun violence prevention and enforcement of existing gun laws. She also advocates licensing of gun owners, reasoning that "a license is required to drive a car, and Congress should establish a similarly straightforward federal licensing system for the purchase of any type of firearm or ammunition." (Driving a car is not a Constitutionally protected right the last time I consulted that document.)

Warren's proposal would also ban future sales of so-called "assault weapons" and "high-capacity"

Warren also believes Congress "should limit the number of guns that can be purchased to one per month. Part of her agenda is the excise taxes on firearms and ammunition that are used to support state wildlife restoration and enhancement projects the 70-year-old Pittman-Robertson Federal Aid to Wildlife Restoration program adopted by Congress in the late 1930s. She believes these taxes should be used elsewhere. (Wildlife can survive without help.)





Warren also advocates for a national waiting period, claiming "over the past 5 years, a national handgun waiting period would have stopped at least 4,550-gun deaths." (If you believe that I have a bridge in Brooklyn, New York you might be interested in buying.)

These are excerpts from the CCRKBA publication dated October 2019. Volume45 No.10. Sometimes you must reiterate the facts before people pay attention to them.

NH: The resurrected "elder care" legislation from the last session had an executive session review recently. There is no pubic report on this executive discussion of this bill that I know of. Stay tuned for more state sponsored shenanigans.
