

USMC Rules for a Gunfight

- 1. Bring a gun. Preferably, bring at least two guns. Bring all of your friends who have guns. Bring four times as much ammo as you think you may need.
- 2. Shoot again. Anything worth shooting is worth shooting twice. Ammo is cheap life is expensive.
- 3. Only hits count. The only thing worse than a miss is a slow miss.
- 4. If your shooting stance is good, you're probably not moving fast enough or using cover correctly.
- 5. Move away from your attacker. Distance is your friend. (Lateral and diagonal movement are preferred.)
- 6. If you can choose what to bring to a gunfight, bring a long gun and a friend with a long gun.
- 7. In ten years nobody will remember the details of caliber, stance, or tactics. They will only remember who lived.
- 8. If you are not shooting, you should be communicating. If you're not communicating, you should be reloading. If you're not reloading, you should be running.
- 9. Accuracy is relative: most combat shooting standards will be more dependent on "pucker factor" than the inherent accuracy of the gun.
- 10. Use a gun that works EVERY TIME. "All skill is in vain when an Angel blows the powder from the flintlock of your musket."
- 11. Someday someone may kill you with your own gun, but they should have to beat you to death with it because it is empty.
- 12. Always cheat, always win. The only unfair fight is the one you lose.

- 13. Have a plan.
- 14. Have a back-up plan, because the first one won't work.
- 15. Use cover or concealment as much as possible.
- 16. Flank your adversary when possible. Protect yours.
- 17. Don't drop your guard.
- 18. Always tactical load and threat scan 360 degrees.
- 19. Watch their hands. Hands kill. (In God we trust. Everyone else, keep your hands where I can see them.)
- 20. Decide to be aggressive ENOUGH, quickly ENOUGH.
- 21. The faster you finish the fight, the less shot you will get.
- 22. Be polite. Be professional. But, have a plan on how to kill everyone you meet.
- 23. Be courteous to everyone, friendly to no one.
- 24. Your number one option for personal security is a lifelong commitment to avoidance, deterrence, and de-escalation.
- 25. Do not attend a gun fight with a handgun, the caliber of which does not start with anything smaller than "4".
- 26. You can't miss fast enough to win.

- E. am not barred by any law from the possession, use, or control of firearms.
