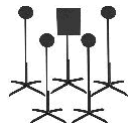

Proposed Bylaw Changes

In accordance with CPFGC Bylaw 13.1, the following proposed amendment to the Club Bylaws was presented at the May Meeting, and will be voted upon at the Monthly Meeting on 16 June.

To change Bylaw Section 5.3, which currently reads:

5.3 The Board of Directors will expend funds for expenditures to committees, Club projects for improvement, repairs, or maintenance of the Club, not to exceed **fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00)** for each expense.

to change the authorized amount and subsequently read:

5.3 The Board of Directors will expend funds for expenditures to committees, Club projects for improvement, repairs, or maintenance of the Club, not to exceed **twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00)** for each expense.

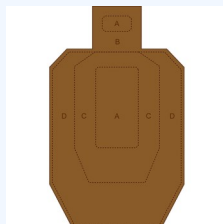

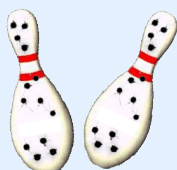
