### An Open Letter to the Browning A-5

There is no better shotgun to bring hunting than an old model Browning Auto-5. Its classic lines, wood furniture, and blue steel mean its aesthetics are not out of place among the finest shotguns. Meanwhile, its capacity and action give it a significant advantage over its double-barreled or pump action cousins. There are many other semi-automatic shotguns on the market today, but none compare to the detail-oriented and feature-rich Browning. From its crisp trigger to its magazine cutoff and easy controls, it is clear that the Auto-5 was designed by a shooter for shooters. This is further evidenced by the fact that the A-5 was manufactured for more than 100 years after its invention by the venerable John Browning. No other modern firearm matches the A-5's longevity, except perhaps the M2 machine gun and the 1911 pistol, both also designed by Mr. Browning.



The A-5 platform also offers exceptional variety. The Light 12 is the most popular, yet 16 gauge, 20 gauge, and magnum variants are also readily available. In addition, the A-5 accepts multiple barrels, meaning your gun can transform from a wing-shooter with a 26 inch barrel and changeable chokes to a deer gun with iron sights that will easily launch a slug 100 yards simply by swapping barrels. The adjustable recoil system also allows the gun to reliably cycle any ammunition from the lightest target loads to the hardest-hitting slugs.

Some will complain that the A-5 is outdated. Its long-stroke recoil operating system is clunky and slow. Yet note that I said it is the greatest hunting shotgun, not the greatest 3-gun action shooting shotgun. The recoil operation also means that the Auto-5 is more durable and reliable than comparable semi-autos. That does mean more felt recoil, but remember, this shotgun was designed when the military was still measuring its cartridges by caliber and grains, not millimeters, and sportsmen could handle a bit of recoil. In short, the Browning Auto-5 is a real hunter's shotgun with a unique blend of beauty, utility, and rugged reliability that makes it second to none in the field.
