The Radio Amateur is...

CONSIDERATE: They never knowingly operate in such a way as to lessen the pleasure of others.

LOYAL: They offer loyalty, encouragement, and support to other amateurs, local clubs, and the IARU Radio Society in their country, through which Amateur Radio in their country is represented nationally and internationally.

PROGRESSIVE: They keep their station up to date. It is well-built and efficient. Their operating practice is above reproach.

FRIENDLY: They operate slowly and patiently when requested; offer friendly advice and counsel to beginners; offer kind assistance, cooperation, and consideration for the interests of others. These are the marks of the amateur spirit.

BALANCED: Radio is a hobby, never interfering with duties owed to family, job, school, or community.

PATRIOTIC: Their station and skills are always ready for service to country and community.
